- The following items will be accepted in Household quantities, at no charge:
- Automobile tires with NO RIMS
- Latex Paint Oil-based/Flammable/Combustible Paint
- Drain cleaners Oven cleaners Kerosene Metal polish
- Arts and crafts supplies Photo chemicals
- Moth Balls Floor cleaners
- Dry cleaning fluid Radiator cleaners
- Rust preventatives Wood preservatives
- Wood strippers Oil based paint
- Paint thinner Solvents
- Degreasers Sealants Gasoline Antifreeze
- Brake fluid Engine and radiator fluids Transmission fluid
- Old home chemistry sets Pesticides Herbicides
- Insect sprays Rodent killers
- Pool chemicals Hydrochloric acid
- Cesspool cleaners Creosote Fertilizer Batteries
- Cooking Fryer Oil/Grease **Containers must be \leq 5-gal (larger containers/drums not accepted)

What NOT To Bring

- Trailer tires, tractor tires , tires with rims
- Agricultural Chemicals
- Dioxins
- LARGE Appliances like washers, dryers, chest type freezers, A/C Units
- Containers Larger Than 5 Gallon
- Explosives
- Large Propane Cylinders
- Medical and Pharmaceutical Items
- Radioactive Materials
- Industrial or Commercial/Business Waste
- No Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Explosives including Ammunition
- Items with Asbestos or Mercury
- Construction and Demolition Debris
- Scrap Metals

Guidelines

Bring products in their original containers.

- Do not mix or consolidate products.
- Properly seal containers to prevent leaking.
- Haul containers in the trunk or back of vehicle, away from passengers.
